- Please meet us on Kaanapali Beach at Whalers Village Shopping Center directly in front of Leilani's Restaurant. Look for our check in sign and crew member on the sand fifteen minutes prior to sail time.
- A large Paid parking lot is available at Whalers Village Shopping Center with hourly fees. We apologize that we can not validate your parking, but the shops or restaurants within Whalers Village can validate with any purchase. This entitles you to three free hours of parking. A small Beach Access parking lot is on the southern border of Whalers Village. Some of the parking stalls are marked "beach access" and are free.
- All Cruises are barefoot and your shoes are stored in lock boxes prior to boarding. We recommend wearing shorts as you can expect to get wet from the knees down while boarding the Hula Girl.
- On Snorkel Sails, please remember to bring a beach towel and sunscreen.
- On evening events we recommend bringing a light jacket or sweater.
